Ventura County ACS/ARES Requirements 2024-09-29

Requirements to apply for Ventura County ARES Membership.

- 1. Minimum of Technician Class Amateur Radio License.
- 2. Must check in to a minimum of five ARES/ACS Nets in their area of residence over an eight net period on that Area's primary 2M Repeater.
- 3. Must meet with their Area EC to discuss the future requirements and timelines associated with their ARES membership.

Requirements to maintain ARES Membership in good standing.

- Check in to at least one ARES/ACS Net in your local ARES/ACS Area on that Area's primary 2M Repeater every month.*
- 2. Complete any mandatory EmComm training course(s) for your ARES/ACS Area within the first three months of membership.
- 3. Complete IS-100 Intro to Incident command System within the first three months of membership.
- 4. Complete IS-700 Introduction to National Incident Mgt. System within the first three months of membership.
- 5. Complete IS-200 ICS for Single Resource within the first six months of membership.
- 6. Complete IS-800 National Response Framework within the first six months of membership.

Requirements to Join ACS.

- 1. Meet or exceed all requirements for ARES Membership as listed above for a minimum of six months.
- 2. Participate in at least one additional ACS/ARES training course for your local ACS/ARES Area.*
- 3. Explain the layout and meaning of the channel numbers and frequencies set forth in the ACS/ARES frequency list.
- 4. Memorize the primary repeater and simplex frequency and settings for your local ACS/ARES Area.
- 5. Demonstrate your ability to manually program in the primary repeater and simplex frequency and settings for your local ACS/ARES Area manually into your HT.
- 6. Act as Net Control for an ACS/ARES check in net from an EOC in your local ACS/ARES Area.
- 7. Have a valid winlink.org email address and reply to a message sent by your EC.
- 8. Submit to and pass a background check by the Ventura County Sheriff's office.

Requirements to maintain ACS Membership in good standing.

- 1. Meet or exceed all requirements for ARES Membership as listed above.
- 2. Check in to at least one ARES/ACS Net in your local ARES/ACS Area on that Area's primary 2M Repeater every month.*
- 3. Complete additional EmComm training courses as available.
- 4. Participate in at least one public event that ARES/ACS is assisting with annually.*
- 5. Participate in at least one Operational Readiness Test (ORT) and/or one ACS/ARES approved maintenance project annually.*
